

## ChargerCon Cosplay Contest 2018 Rules

The Cosplay Contest is a craftsmanship contest. You **must** attend both the pre-judging (TBA) and the actual contest (TBA) in order to be eligible for the competition. Costumes will be judged based on their craftsmanship, presentation, likeness, etc. The list of categories is as follows:

**Novice:** To qualify for this category you must have made or altered at *least* 10% of your outfit, but no more than 40%.

**Journeyman:** To qualify for this category you must have made at least 40% of your outfit, but no more than 90%.

**Master:** To qualify for this category you must have made at least 90% of your outfit.

**Exhibitionist:** You do not have to have made any of your outfit to qualify for this category, however, exhibitionists can not win a prize. You also do not need to attend pre-judging.

### Rules

1. All cosplayers must have a reference image of their character ready during pre-judging.
2. Anything you say onstage must be PG-13.
3. Your cosplay must obey Alabama's nudity laws. Please keep all cosplays as family-friendly as possible.
4. No pyrotechnics will be provided or allowed. Contestants are also not allowed to throw things off the stage. (Props, glitter, etc.)
5. Any weapon at the con must be peace-bonded and non-working. Any blades **must** be sheathed at all times.

The UAH Cosplay and Costuming Club reserves the right to remove any participant of the contest if their behavior threatens con-goers. We also reserve the right to change their category if they enter into one that doesn't suit their outfit, in an effort to be the most fair to all contestants.
